BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Estacada Fire District operates as a public corporation in the State of Oregon. The District provides fire and life safety services to a population of approximately 13,000 citizens within an 88-square mile area. It is made up of suburban, rural, agricultural, and forested lands. The Estacada Rural Fire District No. 69 is funded through a fixed rate on property taxes of \$2.4029 per \$1,000 of assessed value. The area is served by one staffed station and one volunteer station, a training facility, and administration offices. There are 9 career firefighters, 1 Finance Manager, 4 chief officers, an Administrative Assistant and about 50 volunteers in various capacities. The Fire District is a full-service emergency provider answering about 1700 calls for service annually.

The District is governed by a five-member elected Board of Directors. The governing body is given certain powers and authority by the laws of the state. Each member of the governing body is a public official who is charged to act in the best interests of the public they represent. The members are accountable to the public through federal, state, and local laws.

The purpose of this RFP is to establish a contract for the development of a five-year strategic plan.

Request for Proposals (RFP) for Five-Year Strategic Plan

The Estacada Fire District is seeking proposals from qualified consultants to develop a comprehensive five-year strategic plan. This plan will guide the district in achieving its mission of providing high-quality, cost-effective fire protection, emergency medical services, rescue and community risk reduction.

Scope of Work:

The selected consultant will be responsible for the following tasks:

1. Assessment and Analysis:

- Conduct a thorough assessment of the current state of the Estacada Fire District, including strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT analysis).
- o Review existing plans, policies, and procedures.
- Engage with stakeholders, including staff, board of directors, community members, and local government officials, to gather input and feedback.

2. Strategic Planning:
